ORDER

Islamabad the 10 May 2017

S.R.O. **336** (I)/2017 dated **10 May 2017**– WHEREAS the United Nations Security Council vide its Resolutions Nos. 1267(1999), 1333 (2000), 1373 (2001), 1390 (2002), 1455 (2003), 1526 (2004), 1617 (2005), 1735 (2006), 1822 (2008), 1904 (2009), 1988 (2011), 1989 (2011), 2082 (2012), 2083 (2012), 2133 (2014), 2160 (2014), 2161 (2014) and 2170(2014), 2178 (2014), 2199 (2015), 2253 (2015) and 2255 (2015) has directed to apply travel restrictions, arms embargo and to freeze the funds and other financial resources of certain individuals and entities;

AND WHEREAS the United Nations (Security Council) Act, 1948 (XIV of 1948) enjoins upon the Federal Government to apply certain measures for giving effect to the decisions of the United Nations Security Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 2 of the United Nations (Security Council) Act, 1948 (XIV of 1948), the Federal Government is pleased to order that the asset freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 2 of the Security Council Resolution 2253 (2015) and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations **shall no longer apply** to the individual listed in the Annexure to this order as a consequence of the updates made by the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee of the United Nations Security Council.

Annexure

On **1 May 2017**, the entry specified below was **removed** from the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List. The entry was deleted after the Committee concluded its consideration of the de-listing request for this name submitted through the Office of the Ombudsperson established pursuant to Security Council resolution 1904 (2009), and of the Comprehensive Report of the Ombudsperson on this de-listing request. The assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 2 of Security Council resolution 2253 (2015) adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations accordingly no longer apply to this entry
