NOTIFICATION

*Islamabad, the 11th January, 2001*

S. R. O. 37 (I) 2001.—In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of rule 3 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973, the following method, qualifications and other conditions are laid down for appointment to the post of Radio Officer (BPS-18) under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

### METHOD OF APPOINTMENT

The post of Radio Officer (BPS-18) shall be filled in as 50 per cent by initial appointment and 50 per cent by transfer.

### QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR INITIAL APPOINTMENT

On the closing date for receipt of applications as fixed in the relevant advertisement, a candidate for initial appointment to a post must possess the

educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age limits as mentioned against the post concerned in the Schedule to this Notification.

Provided that the maximum age limit shall be relaxed in respect of the candidates specified, and to the extent indicated, in the Initial Appointment to Civil Posts (Relaxation of Upper Age Limit) Rules, 1993, as amended from time to time.

**QUALIFICATIONS/CONDITIONS FOR APPOINTMENT BY TRANSFER**

Appointment by transfer shall be made in accordance with the provisions of rules 7, 8 and 9 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973.

**PROBATION**

Persons appointed by initial appointment or transfer shall be on probation subject to the provisions of section 6 of Civil Servants Act, 1973, read with rule 21 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973.

S. R. O. 38 (I) 2001.—In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of rule-3 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973 the following amendment shall be made in the Recruitment Rules for the post of Chinese Translator (BS-18) under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs notified vide S. R. O. No. 802 (I) 84, dated 19th September, 1984 :—

The existing rule-3 be substituted with the following :

3. Qualification, Experience and Age Limits for Initial Appointment. A Candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience

and must be within the age limits as mentioned against the post concerned in the schedule to this Notification. In these Rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context:

- (i) "Experience" means the experience gained in a regular full-time paid job after obtaining the prescribed basic qualifications;
- (ii) Maximum age limit shall be relaxed in respect of the candidates specified, and to the extent indicated in the Initial Appointment to Civil Posts (Relaxation of upper age limit) Rules, 1993 as amended from time to time; and
- (iii) Eligibility of candidates shall be reckoned as on the closing date fixed for submission of application in accordance with the Recruitment Rules and the Instructions issued by the Government and the Federal Public Service Commission from time to time.

In the Schedule to the aforesaid Recruitment Rules, the existing entries under column (4) against serial number 2, shall be substituted as "40 years".
