The State Bank of Pakistan will launch a Remittance Survey on January 01, 2025, to gain insights into the flow of remittances to Pakistan. Similar surveys were conducted in January 2021 following COVID-19, January 2022 and January 2023, with support from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Pakistani embassies abroad and other stakeholders.

This annual survey helps us analyze how recent factors, such as business conditions and inflation in host countries, exchange rate fluctuations, general economic uncertainties, SBP's policies to facilitate bilateral transactions and Pakistan's economic situation impact remittance flows.

In line with the support provided in the past, the Embassies/ High Commission/Consulates/ are requested to share the survey link and QR Code with Pakistanis residing in their respective countries from Wednesday, January 01 to January 24, 2025, through various channels (social media, WhatsApp groups, websites, Community Welfare Attaché (CWA) offices, etc.).
