ORDER

Islamabad the April 20, 2021

S.R.O. No. 509(I)/2021 dated 20 April 2021 - WHEREAS the United Nations Security Council vide its resolutions Nos. 2140(2014), 2216(2015), 2266(2016), 2342(2017) and 2402(2018) concerning Yemen has directed arms embargo, travel ban and assets freeze against certain individuals and entities under Chapter VII of the United Nations Charter;

AND WHEREAS the United Nations (Security Council) Act, 1948 (XIV of 1948) enjoins upon the Federal Government to apply certain measures for giving effect to the decisions of the United Nations Security Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 2 of the United Nations (Security Council) Act, 1948 (XIV of 1948), the Federal Government is pleased to order that the individual listed in the Annexure to this shall stand subjected to travel ban arms embargo and assets freeze, in accordance with the aforesaid UNSC resolutions with immediate effect.

Zabin has played a prominent role in a policy of intimidation and of use of systematic arrest, detention, torture, sexual violence and rape against politically active women. Zabin as director of CD is directly responsible for, or by virtue of his authority responsible for, and complicit in the use of multiple places of detention including house arrest, police stations, formal prison and detention centres and undisclosed detention centres. In these sites, women including at least one minor, were forcibly disappeared, repeatedly interrogated, raped, tortured, denied timely medical treatment and subject to forced labor. Zabin himself directly inflicted torture in some cases.
