H.E. High Commissioner Muhammad Saleem called on H.E. the Hon. Job Y. Ndogai, Speaker of the National Assembly of the United Republic of Tanzania, in the Parliament House in Dodoma on September 01, 2021. The High Commissioner conveyed greetings from the Hon. Chairman Senate of Pakistan as well as from the Hon. Speaker National Assembly of Pakistan to the Speaker National Assembly of Tanzania. The two sides expressed satisfaction on the existing collaboration between Parliaments of Tanzania and Pakistan in the Inter-Parliamentary Union as well as the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association. The High Commissioner also briefed about the regional situation including the latest developments in Afghanistan and the gross human rights violations by Indian occupation forces in Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir.



H.E. Muhammad Saleem called on the Hon. Dr. Dorothy Gwajima, Minister of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children of the United Republic of Tanzania in Dodoma on September 30, 2021. Prospects for Pakistan-Tanzania collaboration in professional education/training including specializations in medical, nursing, pharmaceutical and paramedical fields were discussed. Information on the promotion of bilateral trade and prospects for production of medicines; medical devices and virology/immunology sectors was also shared.



The Defence and Martyrs Day of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan (06 September) was celebrated at the High Commission in Dar es Salaam with traditional enthusiasm and patriotism. A large number of Pakistani Community members including families, children and their Tanzanian friends attended the event. Mr. Muhammad Saleem, High Commissioner, read out the Special Messages of the President and the Prime Minister of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan on the occasion. In his remarks, Mr. Saleem paid rich tribute to the Martyrs, Ghazis and National Heroes of the 1965 war. The High Commissioner also paid tribute to Late Syed Ali Shah Geelani Shaheed who died recently on September 02, 2021, while facing years long house arrest in Srinagar in Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir. Mr. Saleem briefed the participants about the ongoing aggression by Indian

occupation forces including continued military siege, torture, human rights violations, lockdown and even denying the right of funeral and burial for Geelani Shaheed's family and followers in IIOJ&K.

The High Commissioner briefed the Commissioner General about the economic diplomacy initiatives and existing trade and investment pattern in recent years between Pakistan and Tanzania.
